




### DEDICATED TO DISCOVERY... COMMITTED TO CARE



2013 NOTEABLE RESEARCH AND PATIENT CARE BREAKTHROUGHS

Thanks to your support and dedication, this year Dana-Farber:

- Used whole genome sequencing to **identify new mutations driving 71 percent of skin cancers**—the
  first-ever discovery in what was previously known as
  "iunk" DNA
- Launched a free nutrition app called *Ask the Nutritionist: Recipes for Fighting Cancer* that helps patients undergoing treatment
- Completed more than 5,000 genetic profiles of tumor DNA as part of *Profile*, an unprecedented research study that is creating the world's largest database of genetic abnormalities in cancer
- Induced complete remission lasting a median of three years in patients with advanced CLL through use of a vaccine
- Headed the first large scale study of female pediatric cancer survivors and found that **infertility rates for the group were lower than previously thought**




